1. Alignment with Mission (Score: 0-5)

5: Perfect alignment with the Foundation's mission

0-1: Minimal alignment

2. Community Empowerment & Inclusivity (Score: 0-3)

3: Strong focus on community empowerment

0-1: Limited focus

3. Outreach (Score: 0-3)

3: Comprehensive strategy for global outreach

0-1: Minimal strategy

4. Innovation and Creativity (Score: 0-2)

2: Highly innovative and creative approaches

0-1: Traditional approaches

5. Budget Justification (Score: 0-3)

3: Budget thoroughly justified and realistic

0: Budget poorly detailed

6. Timeline and Outcomes (Score: 0-2)

2: Well-defined timeline with measurable outcomes

0: Unrealistic timeline with vague outcomes

7. Assessment of Risk (Score: 0-2)

2: No significant risks
