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UBIS New 5-Year Plan

An earnest strategy for organized growth.

On a beautiful fall weekend in early November, the Urantia Book Internet School (UBIS) Board met at the Foundation Headquarters in Chicago for their annual meeting. Director Georges Michelson Dupont prepared an agenda designed to plan for the development of the UBIS in

Building on the school's foundation, carefully constructed under the leadership of former director, Dorothy Elder, ten members of the Board (Georges Michelson Dupont, Pam Maunakea, Polly Friedman, Olga Lopez, Ralph Zehr, Betty Zehr, Tom Brachna, Judy Coskey, Susan Flacks, and Jay Peregrine) met to begin building a framework for the next level of the school's growth.

Georges introduced Olga Lopez, a new member of the Board, who is the director of the newly launched Spanish UBIS. Olga is highly qualified for this position. Fluent in English and Spanish, she has taken courses in the English UBIS, given a course in English, and taken the teacher training class. She will teach the first UBIS course in Spanish during the January, 2012 trimester.

Next, Georges explained the purpose of the meeting. We will envision where we want the UBIS to be in 5 years, and then will create an organization to make this vision a reality. We will focus on the English UBIS, knowing that the Spanish UBIS, and future schools developed in other languages, will mirror the organization of the English UBIS.

Fostering Thoughtful UBIS Growth in Another Language

Next January, the UBIS is going to give its first course in Spanish with the new website. Before that time, there has been a long period of training and preparation for this moment to come.

A few years ago, Georges Michelson-Dupont, now the UBIS director, suggested that I participate in the UBIS as a student, with the intention of becoming a T/F and thus developing the Spanish UBIS. I felt

this was a great educational opportunity for the Spanish speaking readership to take, so I immediately agreed.

As you may know, before becoming a Teacher/Facilitator, one needs to attend at least two courses as a student, and after that attending a Teacher Training Course (TTC). And this is what I did; I attended three courses as a student and two TTC before becoming a T/F. I also gave one course in the English UBIS, in order to get more experience for the Spanish UBIS. As you might guess, it has been something very challenging to me, because I had to give a course in another language which is not my native language, but the feedback that I received from my students and the perspective of giving courses in my mother language are worth the effort.

Urantia Book Internet School was created and exists as a means to help students from all over the world study *The Urantia Book* together free from the constraints of distance, timetables, and physical presence.

Right now there is a test course in Spanish, attended by 13 students coming from 9 different countries, with very good results in general. Website is working fine and it's almost translated into Spanish. We're having no technical problems and this course is going really well. Now I'm looking forward to launching the Spanish UBIS officially next January. For the time being, I'm the only T/F in Spanish, so if you are interested in joining me in this effort, your help would be really appreciated! Little by little, step by step, our plan is developing a core of teachers/ facilitators in Spanish so more courses can be offered in this language, with the same high standards that the English UBIS has. This way we'll be able to serve the growing Spanish speaking community of readers and to fulfill our mission of training leaders and teachers for the sake of the spiritual upliftment of our planet.

Polly Friedman has developed a teacher training program to address this issue. Another concern facing the school is the high dropout rate. The Board developed four strategies to ensure that prospective students understand what a UBIS course entails before they register.

By the end of the meeting, six committees had been formed to implement the 5-year goals:

- 1. The Curriculum Development Committee (CDC) in charge of course development.
- 2. The Students Committee (ST) in charge of all matters related to student activities.
- 3. The Faculty Development Committee (FDC) in charge of Teacher recruitment and activities.
- 4. The Course Review Committee (CRC) in charge of helping teachers to develop their courses, and reviewing all courses before they are offered.
- 5. The Teacher Training Program Committee (TTPC) in charge of training students to become teachers.
- 6. The Public Relation Committee (PRC) in charge of the reader service and the Newsletter.
